Dear Sir or Madam,

I am contacting you as a lawyer of Eriks Martinovskis current director of the Luxembourg company Gaz Capital S.A.

In this regard I am referring to the following alert: <https://www.offshorealert.com/tag/eriks-martinovskis/>

My client was appointed on 24 August 2022 as director of the company Gaz Capital S.A., the fine was imposed for late publishing of annual accounts.

The accounts should have been filed until 30 June 2022 but were only filed on 27 July 2022.

The deadline for publication of the annual accounts was missed before he was appointed. The individuals to blame are the previous directors.

The fine was due and paid but was not due to any mistake or breach done by my client, the mistake was done by the previous directors who were in office as of 30 June 2022. My client was only appointed when the breach was already done.

The offshore alert however has an impact on my client's reputation. My client is acting as independent company director for a number of companies and now received several requests of worried clients because of this alert.
