The Incredible Hunt for Billionaire Russian Criminal Viktor Bout (And His Subsequent Release for a U.S. Basketball Player)

Russian billionaire Viktor Bout was the world's foremost arms dealer. Known as the 'Merchant of Death', he was both 'Public Enemy No. 1' to the global intelligence agencies who hunted him and a ruthless criminal worth a fortune. He was also a former KGB officer and a tool of the Kremlin.

This session will go into 'Operation Relentless', the remarkable top-secret mission masterminded by former British Special Air Service elite soldier Mike Snow and a handful of U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration operatives to hunt down Bout and bring him to justice - and discuss his release many years later in a seemingly lop-sided prisoner swap with U.S. basketball player Brittney Griner.
